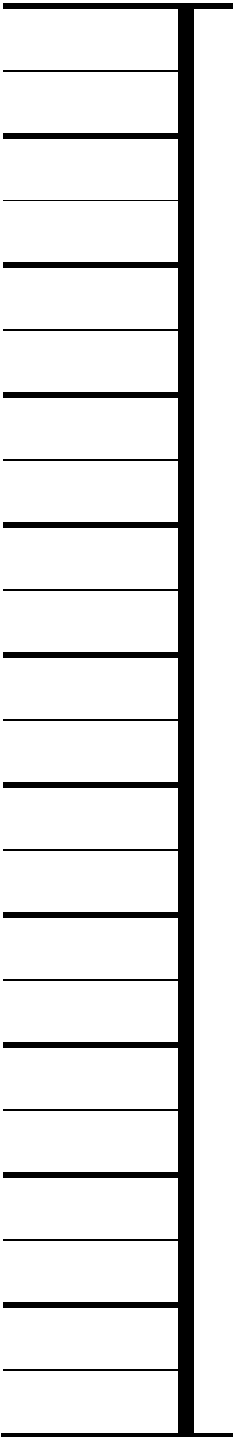

Timeline of subject's life. Each line is five years. Use the white space next to the timeline to write about events that fall into that area of the timeline (remember to include the exact year on those).



Early Years. If something about this person's early years are known, list them here. These events may have helped shape the course of this person's life. For example, if the person's parents saw a certain talent that he or she had as a child, they might have sent him or her to a special school to build up those skills. This education, in turn, may have set this person on the path of his or her life's work.

Personal Attributes. List some of the person's strengths and weaknesses. Some examples: ambitious, intelligent, mean, neglectful, wise. Cite examples of why you think these attributes apply, such as, "*Person* was mean because he always pulled the wings off of flies."

Contributions. Why do we remember this person? What did this person contribute during his or her lifetime?

Impressions. How does knowing about this person's life affect you? Is there a behavior that this person showed that you'd like copy or emulate? Is there anything good that you can learn from this person's life?
